

Monksdale Allotments, 149 plots, sits on land historically formed by the Monksdale Brook valley. Before the 1920s, the surrounding area was mostly open grassland and agricultural smallholdings. The Allotments were established in 1925 for working class families living in the neighbouring terraced housing. During WWII, Monksdale was part of a city-wide food movement and post war Monksdale survived because it was classified as a municipal/council site.
